

MENS' BASKETBALL PROGRAM 2019-2020 CONDITIONS OF PLAY

This program is intended to provide adult men (18 yrs. +) the opportunity to participate in a socially competitive athletic activity. Teams are randomly chosen on a per session basis by shooting free throws with first to successfully accomplish the shot comprising the initial teams. Substitutions may occur as necessary and play is officiated by the game participants. Baskets count as 1 point with the conclusion of each game being either 11 or 15 points depending on the number of other participants waiting to play. The number of games played per session may vary depending on the amount of time required to complete each game. Participants not eligible to participate in a previous game will have the opportunity to play in the following game. All participants are expected to abide by all rules, regulations, guidelines and policies established by the Park District as well as any and all determinations that need be made by the gymnasium supervisor. Persons using offensive language, demonstrating unsafe play, disregarding policies/procedures, demonstrating unsportsmanlike behavior or, in any other manner, preventing the activity from occurring as intended will be required to leave the facility and be subject to a determination of forfeiture of future privileges of participation. In order to assure the intentions of this program are maintained the following conditions of play apply.

- Only persons properly registered with the District will be allowed in the gymnasium during program sessions.
- a) Due to limited space and considerations for safe play we are unable to admit spectators.
- b) Roster substitutions are not permitted. Registrants will forfeit the right of participation for permitting "others" to play in their place
- Due to other scheduled gymnasium activities no activity associated with this program may begin before 6:00 P.M.
- Program participants may arrive no earlier than 5:45 P.M. to use locker room facilities.
- a) The Park District assumes no responsibility for the protection or recovery of lost or stolen valuables.
- b) All articles of clothing unnecessary for program participation should be maintained in the locker room area.
- c) Articles of clothing which contain wording or symbols that could be offensive to the general public will not be allowed to be worn during program activities.
- d) The wearing of hats by program participants is considered a safety issue and, as such, may not be worn in the activity area.
- All program participants must be out of the building by 8:30 P.M., (7:30 on Thursdays)
- All program participants are required to conduct themselves in a manner considerate of all rules, regulations and policies established by the Park District.
- a) Participants must always be considerate of others using the facilities.
- b) Offensive language will be cause for expulsion from the facility.
- c) Rough or dirty play will be cause for expulsion from the facility.
- d) Persons who prevent or disrupt the activity from commencing in its intended manner will be required to leave the facility.
- Any person required to leave the facility may, upon evaluation of the circumstances of the incident, lose the privilege of future participation.
- Any refund of registration does not extend to use of other non-related District facilities.
- The gymnasium supervisor will call for medical attention when requested/required. However, the District will not assume responsibility for any costs associated with such attention.
- The gymnasium supervisor has absolute authority on any and all matters regarding the management of the facility, programs and activities. Any person ignoring or disputing this authority will be required to leave the facility.
